We understand, due to national scandals, that those who choose cremation might have doubts about the process and procedures of cremation. Our 10-step cremation process guarantees that your loved one is always in our care and that the cremated remains are those of your loved one.

This brochure will help answer any questions you may have about our 10-step cremation process and the commitment we have to every family we serve.

One... Your loved one is always in our care

We have a state-of-the-art crematory located in the funeral home. Unlike other funeral homes that use third-party crematories, making it impossible for them to manage and supervise the cremation, at McCrery you can have peace of mind knowing that your loved one is under the care of our trained and certified staff at all times. If you like, you can even witness the start of the cremation process in our private viewing room.

Two... Safeguarding personal identity

To ensure security, a personal identification band is placed on your loved one at the moment they are received into our care.



Three... Unique tracking system

Upon arrival at our facility, a personal identification sheet is generated to track every phase of the cremation process. Information such as the transfer technician, day and time of arrival, and a list of personal belongings are logged on the document, which stays with your loved one throughout the duration of the process. Your loved one's personal belongings are placed in a secure area for their return to the family.

Four... Family identification

Your loved one will be bathed and dressed in the clothes provided by the family or in a gown we provide, and then will be gently placed in a cremation container, or if you choose, an all-wood cremation casket. Then, we will ask you, or a representative, to positively identify him or her prior to cremation.

Five... Checks and balances to ensure correct paperwork

Two individuals, a cremation technician and a funeral home staff member, will review all cremation paperwork and permits and submit them to the medical examiner. This is to ensure authorizations and permits have been received and properly documented. Once all documentation is verified, the medical examiner will grant approval to perform the cremation.

Fix... Details before the cremation

Immediately prior to the cremation process, your loved one is assigned a unique identification number on their personal identification sheet, which is also recorded in our cremation log book. A matching metal tag is placed with your loved one. Such information as the date and time of cremation and the crematory operator's name are also recorded on the personal identification sheet. The crematory operator will initial that they have verified the identity, and will attach the cremation permit to the personal identification sheet.

Seven... Details during the cremation

The cremation permit and personal identification sheet are placed on the outside of the cremation chamber during the cremation process. The metal ID tag remains with your loved one inside the cremation chamber.

Eight... Details after the cremation

After the cremation is complete, the cremated remains are placed with the metal identification tag into an urn. The personal identification sheet is placed into our permanent files.

Vine... Final disposition of the cremated remains

Our professional staff can assist in determining the right choice for you, be it burial, scattering or permanent possession. Many families also choose to have a committal or graveside service at the cemetery.

Zen... Celebration of life

We will assist in planning a funeral or memorial service, either before or after the cremation, which will appropriately celebrate the life of your loved one. A meaningful ceremony provides an opportunity for family and friends to pay tribute to your loved one and to share the memories of a lifetime.
